REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

1. CV.
2. Written materials : sample from written scientific work of the candidate (up to 3000 words) or his scientific publication.

PROCEDURE

The admission procedure includes two stages:

1. Development on research project in chosen thematic area form the list of topics.

The project should contain the following items:

- research problem;
- basic research issues;
- basic research hypotheses;
- methodology

2. An interview with the candidate on a research project previously prepared by him.

THEMATIC TOPICS

1. Values and work motivation.
2. Attitudes towards work (job satisfaction, organizationsl commitment and job engagement).
3. Individual differences in the workplace. Emotional intelligence.
4. Career choice and career management in the organization.
5. Organizational culture. Characteristics and typologies.
6. Leadership and leadership styles.
7. Conflict management in the organization.
8. Cross-cultural differences in organizational behavior.
